

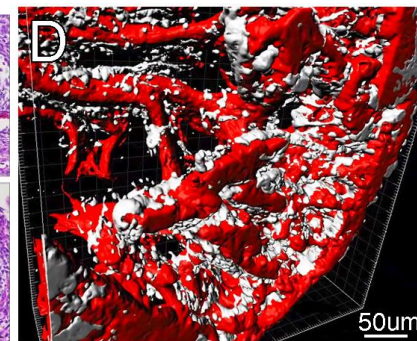
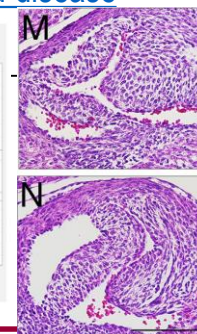
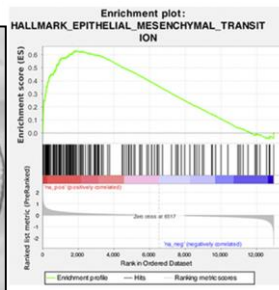
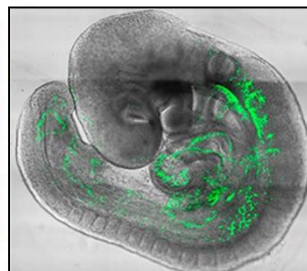
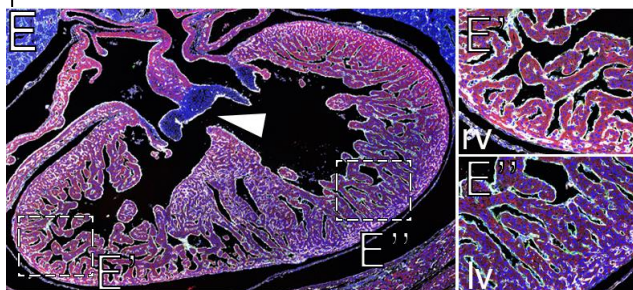
Master student at the Centro Nacional de Investigaciones Cardiovasculares (CNIC), Madrid
