"On a decimal scale of 0-10 and with 2 decimal places, equal to or higher than 8.00 for Biomedicine fields of knowledge, except for double degree studies or those belonging to the following engineering fields: biomedical engineering, electrical engineering, electronic engineering and telecommunication engineering; industrial engineering, mechanical engineering, automatic engineering, computer and systems engineering; chemical engineering, materials engineering, or similar, which will be equal to or higher than 7.00."(3).
